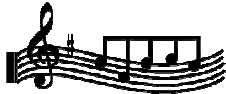
Sue and Brian Masters would like to thank everyone for their prayers and concern for their grandson Aiden Masters. He is now at home and making good progress.

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Obra de 7 Tom sobre O Saeculorum, which is anonymous in the late 17th century MS at Braga in which it is found. An imposing fugal piece based on the plainchant melodic phrase of the Gloria, the subject mainly appears in semibreves, but is also heard in reduced note values in the final section after a brief section in 3/2. During the Communion I shall play the Elevazione in G minor by G.B. Martini of Bologna (1706-84).
