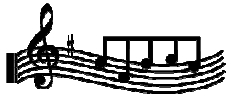

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be Toccata Decima by Gerolamo Frescobaldi (1583-1643) who was organist of St. Peter's Rome. Probably the most influential composer of keyboard music in the 1st half of the 17th century, he published several volumes of pieces, this Toccata coming from the 1st book of Toccatas of 1615. After a short chordal and slow opening it dissolves into sections of fast, sometimes sequential passagework, and a wide variety of rhythmic figures.
