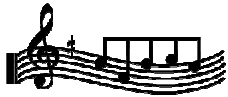

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Tenro de 2 Tom by Pedro de Araújo, (ca. 1640-1705) who was organist in Braga. About 12 pieces survive in two manuscripts now in Porto and Braga. This piece, found in the Porto library, is imitative, slower, and more reflective and contains several subjects, concluding with the cross-shaped motif popular in this period.

During Communion I shall play the Per L'elevazione in F from the Cimino MS, Naples ca. 1675 and the Durezza e Ligature in F by Ercole Pasquini (ca 1560-1619); these pieces being based on conflict and resolution are most suitable for Remembrance Sunday.
