A belated but **HUGE** thank you to Lucy who spent her October half term holiday single-handily cleaning down the side hall and giving it a much needed fresh coat of paint.



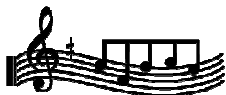

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Tocata de mano derecha de 8 Tono, which is preserved anonymously in the manuscript source in Barcelona, but it may well be by either Pedro Rabassa (1683-1760) or Vicente Rodríguez (1690-1760) who were organists in Valencia. It is in three sections, each in 6/8 with some cross-rhythms, followed by a Minuet. The solo is in the right hand and comprises some lively, jaunty writing especially in the jig-like second section.

Organist on tour: On Saturday 21st November, John will be giving a lecture and recital of 30 minutes each at Christ Church, Spitalfields, as part of a conference organised by the British Institute of Organ Studies.
