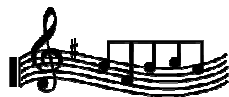

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Toccata in E minor by Matthias Weckmann (1616-74) who was organist of the Jacobikirche, Hamburg. In addition to vocal and chamber music, several compositions for keyboard survive in manuscripts. This piece, one of six Toccatas, is full of rhetorical drama which shows the influence of his friend Froberger; after an opening of a steadily building chord, there follow virtuoso arpeggiations punctuated by dissonant chords before the second section comprising repeated quaver chords in the right hand over dotted rhythms in the left hand, the piece closing with further virtuoso flourishes leading to a short chordal close.
