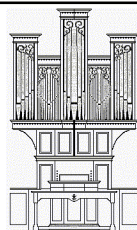
John will be playing an organ recital to commemorate the 400th anniversary of the death of Shakespeare on (23rd April (St. George's Day)1616).

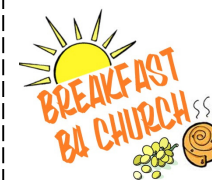
