VICAR'S SABBATICAL LEAVE

Our vicar, Brian, has been invited by Bishop Martin to take 'Sabbatical' leave this year, granted to all Anglican ministers, for every 10 years of full time ordained ministry they have served. Brian's leave begins in August, when he will be attending the **Global Leadership Summit** at Willow Creek Church, Chicago, USA, with Bishop Richard Jackson. After 3 weeks in Chicago Brian and Christine will fly to Canada and California, visiting friends and local Churches on their travels. After some time in the Southern USA they fly to New York and possibly Florida, before their return in mid November, in time for Christmas.

We pray for them to be kept safe as they visit North America and enjoy a time of rest and renewal. Rev Sue Foster will cover Brian's duties in his absence.

TEAR FUND in D. R. CONGO

During the political turmoil in the UK in recent weeks, we have not heard much about the horror of conflict in the **Democratic Republic of Congo**. TEAR Fund have been working in **DRC** since 1986, supporting 11 partners, 8 in the east and 3 in the west. They run relief projects, promoting water & sanitation, school reconstruction, health education & food security.
