The Voluntary after the service today will be the Medio Registro de 8 Tono de dos bajos which is anonymous in the source, MS. 1358 in the Biblioteca Nacional, Madrid, one of four compiled by Martin y Coll between 1706-9, but the pieces in the opening 80 folios are probably by Andrés Lorente (1624-1703), theorist and organist in Alcalá de Henares. The title tells us that it is in G and that the two lower voices carry the solo writing, although frequently only one is present. It is in four sections, nos. 2 and 4 being in triple time.

The music during Communion will be the Falsas de 5 Tono from MS. 1360, of 1709
