The Voluntary after the service today will be the Offertoire in C by Caleb Simper (1856-1928) who was organist at Barnstaple. In addition to many anthems, he published 12 volumes of Voluntaries, this piece being found in volume 6. Broadly similar to a March in style, in ternary form, the first section is repeated after a more song-like central section. Its lively exuberance makes it an ideal conclusion to the Harvest Festival.
