At the beginning of 2016 our Church Council (PCC) agreed certain 'Aims & Objectives' to work on during the year. Our Vision for the next 3 years to 2020, by God's grace, is that:

1. Attendance at Sunday and weekday services, plus Christian groups, to increase to 150 per week.
2. To be known throughout the Community for our welcome and support to individuals and families, using a variety of relevant ways to share and show God's love, encouraging children, teenagers and adults to personal faith in God and Christian life style.
3. To have trained and effective leaders for all Groups, Services, Outreach and Pastoral care.
4. To be financially sustainable, with Church and Hall buildings structurally sound, cost effective and fit for a variety of uses by the Church and the Community.
