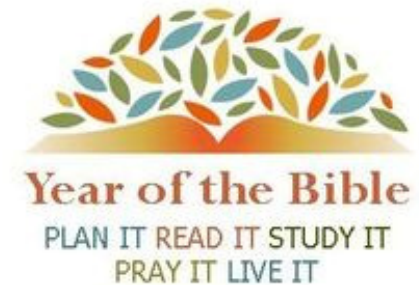
## THE REAL ADVENT CALENDAR
