ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service will be Toccata Sexta by Johann Eberlin (1702-62) who was Kapellmeister and organist in Salzburg. Most of his output was dramatic and choral, but in 1747 he published a set of nine Toccatas in two movements. This one opens with a short prelude full of suspensions and syncopations followed by a fugue in which the interval of a sixth is prominent. During the Communion I shall play a Falsas by Cabanilles.
