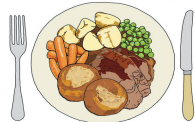

OUR CHURCH ACTION PLAN 2019

At the beginning of this year our PCC (Church Council) agreed certain 'Aims & Objectives' to work on during the next 12 months. REDEVELOPEMENT PLANS

The PCC are pleased to say that the Diocese has finally approved our plans for new flooring, chairs and audio-visual and we can apply to the Chancellor for the legal permission to carry out the work.

First a notice must be displayed outside the church for 28 days, outlining the plans. This is to allow anyone with an interest to make comment. During this time there will be a small display in church, and the plans will be available in the office for inspection (by arrangement with Helen A). After that, and taking note of any comments made, the Diocesan Chancellor will make the final decision on what work we can go ahead with.
